Morgan Factory Tour

The Morgan Experience Centre is located on Spring Lane in Malvern Link, WR14 2LS. Please park in the main visitor car park and check in at Reception with the Morgan Experience team. The Tour starts at 1100 so please be ready at least 10—15 mins before the tour starts. The Group will be split between several guides with a short interval between each tour, but assume you are leaving at 1100. The tour takes between 1.5 and 2 hours. Please note that the factory will be a little quieter than during the week due to reduced staffing levels. There is a café on site.

The cost per person is £29.50, payable in advance please by BACS to: Barclays, 20-81-11 60252611 Or by cheque payable please to CMI.

There is also the option of a cold buffet lunch, with sweet, at £12 per head. This includes a drink station for tea and coffee. Last orders for food on a Saturday is at 1330 and with a larger group the catering staff are unlikely to be able to deal with ad hoc orders. This is normal practice for groups of 10 or more arriving at much the same time. You may well wish to arrive early and avail yourself of breakfast and get something later at Toddington Station.
